Norma Jane Gray gave our devotion on Life situations and to see God's will from Luke.

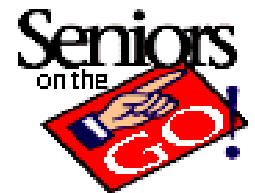
The Minutes and treasurer reports were read and approved.
